

All you need to know about how to get your COVID-19 vaccination in

Eastbourne, Hailsham and Seaford

Your local NHS is working hard to offer all adults a COVID-19 booster vaccination by January. Here, we explain how to get your booster jab.

- 1 All adults are now eligible for a booster vaccination. You can also still receive your 1st and 2nd vaccines at all local services.
- 2 The best way to arrange your vaccination is to book an appointment.
- 3 You can have a booster 3 months from your 2nd vaccine. If it's been 2 months, you can now book an appointment in advance by using the National Booking Service.
- 4 You can use the National Booking Service online or by calling 119. Calls are free and language support is available. You can book appointments for 1st, 2nd and booster vaccines.
- 5 New appointments are being added every day with sites opening for longer hours and on more days.
- 6 Some local services are also contacting people directly to arrange an appointment.
- 7 Don't contact your GP practice about your booster vaccine. It's important to keep phones and online systems clear for patients with a health related need.
- 8 Unless you are contacted by your practice, GP appointments should be attended as planned. If anything changes, your practice will contact you.
