

# It's never too late to get your COVID-19 vaccine!



IF YOU ARE...	YOU CAN GET...
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Aged 18 and over</li><li>• You are a frontline health or social care worker</li><li>• You live or work in a care home</li><li>• You are aged 16 or over and are a main carer for someone at high risk from COVID-19</li><li>• You are aged 16 or over and live with someone who has a weakened immune system (such as someone who has HIV, has had a transplant or is having certain treatments for cancer, lupus or rheumatoid arthritis)</li><li>• Aged 16 and 17 with a health condition that puts you at high risk of getting seriously ill from COVID-19</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Two doses</b>, at least 3 months apart</li><li>• <b>Booster</b> from three months (91 days) after second dose</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Aged 12 and over and have been severely immunosuppressed</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Two doses</b>, at least 3 months apart</li><li>• <b>Third dose</b> at least 8 weeks after second dose</li><li>• <b>Booster</b> from three months (91 days) after third dose</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Aged 12-15 with a health condition that puts you at higher risk from Covid-19, or you are a household contact of someone who is immunosuppressed</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Two doses</b>, at least 3 months apart</li><li>• <b>Third dose</b> at least 8 weeks after second dose</li><li>• <b>Booster</b> from three months (91 days) after third dose</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Aged 12-17 and not in any of the above groups</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Two doses</b>, at least 3 months apart</li></ul>

The National Booking System is open to everyone over the age of 18.

The NHS is prioritising bookings for boosters and is urging people to book a slot to guarantee their vital job. The best way to get your booster quickly is by booking online or by calling 119 but if walk in centres have capacity to do so, they can vaccinate adults aged 18 and over immediately.

If you've had a positive COVID-19 test you need to wait before getting any dose of the vaccine. You need to:

- **Wait 4 weeks (28 days)** if you're aged 18 years old or over
- **Wait 12 weeks (84 days)** if you're aged 12 to 17 years old
- **Wait 4 weeks (28 days)** if you're aged 12 to 17 years old and at high risk from COVID-19
